PERFORMERS WILL COMPETE IN FOUR CATEGORIES

I.	Junior Piano (up to age 13 or in 8th grade)	\$100 1st Place Award
II.	Senior Piano (up to age 18, not in college)	\$150 1st Place Award
III.	Winds/Brass (up to age 18, not in college)	\$150 1st Place Award
IV.	Strings/Harp (up to age 18, not in college)	\$150 1st Place Award

On Sunday, January 28, 2024, at 3:00 p.m., **up to two finalists** in each category will perform in the Sinfonietta Bel Canto (SBC) concert at St. Paul's UCC Church in Downers Grove. **All** finalists will perform with orchestra accompaniment. During the concert, one winner will be chosen from each category; also, the audience will select their favorite performer. Each 1st place winner and the "Audience Favorite" will receive a monetary award as enumerated above. (In cases of Audience Favorite ties, monetary award will be divided.)

Application Process:

1. Entrants apply online at <u>www.sinfoniettabelcanto.org</u>, under "The SBC Concerto" tab near the top which includes all forms, guidelines, and payment button. A completed submission includes all authorizations, fees, and video link (see next page).

Submission deadline is 11:59 p.m., Friday, December 15, 2023

2. Finalists from each category will be chosen to compete in the live concert on Sunday, January 28, 2024.

SBC reserves the right to limit number of applicants, combine categories and/or alter number of finalists.

3. Finalists must also be available to rehearse on Saturday, January 27, 2024 from 1 - 4 p.m. and on Sunday, January 28, 2024 from 1:30 - 2:30 p.m.

SBC Concerto Competition 2024: Application/Competition/Audition Rules

Application/Competition Rules (in addition to previous page)

- 1. Open to performers up to the age of 18, not in college, who live within a 20 mile radius of Downers Grove IL. Performers will compete in one of four categories; all ages are by the date of the Finalists concert:
 - I. Junior Piano (up to age 13 or in 8th grade)
 - II. Senior Piano (up to age 18, not in college)
 - III. Winds/Brass: standard winds/brass in an orchestra, including saxophone (up to age 18, not in college)
 - IV. Strings/Harp: standard strings in an orchestra, plus harp (up to age 18, not in college)
 All finalists are invited to compete in a **live**, **final round** with orchestra.
- 2. Before applying, entrants should consult/download the "Repertoire Guidelines" PDF, which includes sample repertoire, under "The SBC Concerto" tab on the SBC website: www.sinfoniettabelcanto.org. Please email SBCConcerto@gmail.com if you have questions about repertoire. Entrants will be disqualified if repertoire does not meet the "Repertoire Guidelines" PDF.
- Entrants must select repertoire according to the "Repertoire Guidelines" PDF. Entrants can select any classical repertoire with orchestral accompaniments available through Luck's Music **Library**, www.lucksmusic.com. The piece must not exceed 7 minutes in length. Music must be for purchase only, not for rental. While SBC will purchase the orchestral parts, the price may not exceed \$150. On the Luck's website, the piece's listing must indicate a "Set" with a price and usually a string count. If Luck's website states "Score," this does NOT mean individual orchestra parts; it must state "Set." If you can't find a particular piece on the Luck's website, contact Luck's directly. See the "Repertoire Guidelines" PDF for sample repertoire & instructions.
- 4. Entries are submitted to SBCConcerto@gmail.com by 11:59pm, Friday, December 15, 2023.
- 5. Entries must include the following 2 steps:
 - **a.** Items in one email with entrant's name in subject line: (Incomplete entries are disqualified.)
 - Fully completed entry form (fillable on your computer or print/fill out), as attachment
 - PDF of sheet music, with any cuts indicated, as attachment
 - Photo providing proof of possession of original copy, as attachment
 - YouTube video link (see #7 below) in the main body of the email
 - **b.** \$45 entry fee, via credit card or PayPal on SBC website (Look under "SBC Concerto" tab.)
- 6. Please note entry fee is non-refundable.

- 7. Video must have been recorded within the last 6 months and use live piano or high-quality recorded piano/keyboard accompaniment. No editing, splicing, or enhancements in any part of the video at any time. Video should clearly show entire instrument or keyboard/pedaling in a static/non-moving view. Video must be uploaded to YouTube as "Unlisted" or "Public" (NOT "Private") and must include the entrant's full name, name of piece, and competition category in the uploader comments section.
- 8. Finalists must be available to rehearse with orchestra on January 27, 2024 from 1:00-4:00 p.m., and on Sunday, January 28, 2024 from 1:30 2:30 p.m.
- 9. Finalists will be announced via email by January 3, 2024. To see the judges' comment sheets, indicate "yes" on the entry form.
- 10. Finalists will be contacted via email approximately 2 weeks before the concert with the final round rehearsal schedule.

Audition Rules

- 1. Performers must perform from memory.
- 2. Performers should select one (1) approved piece, as described previously. Repertoire should not exceed 7 minutes in length including any orchestra alone sections; employ cuts where needed.
- 3. Performers will be judged using the following criteria: Tone, Technique, Accuracy, Interpretation, and Stage Presence.
- 4. Entrants must provide proof of possession of an original copy of the music by attaching a photo of the original and attaching it to the entry email. On January 28, finalists also must bring an original copy of the music. The PDF sheet music attachment *must have cuts indicated*. (Numbering all measures is highly recommended as you'll receive better judges' comments, but not required.)
- 5. Contestants will be assigned a rehearsal time on January 27, 2024 from 1:00-4:00 p.m. and on Sunday, January 28, 2024 from 1:30 2:30 p.m. Times are not negotiable.
- 6. Location for all rehearsals & the concert is St. Paul's UCC Church, 5739 Dunham Road, Downers Grove, IL. (enter thru door in back & come upstairs to the Sanctuary)
- 7. Rehearsals are not open to the public.
- 8. No flash photography at rehearsals or performances.
- 9. The judges' decisions are final.
